# Business Spotlight

## Barnes Greenhouse

Barnes Greenhouse is a 5th generation family owned business that was founded in 1890 by Benjamin and Elizabeth Barnes. The family owners through the years include Hugh Barnes, Donald and Mildred Barnes, Larry and Donna Barnes Christy, and now Mike and Beth Mack and Eric Christy. During this time, you will find the staff at Barnes getting all of their plants ready for their upcoming season. They sell the products grown in house as well as additional shrubs, trees, and plants purchased from other greenhouses and nurseries. The garden center is open seasonally from March to October. Customers from this area flock there this time of year ready for the sight of getting things growing. Their early spring hours are 8:30-5:00 Monday-Saturday and in May they extend their hour to 6:00 PM on Friday nights and are also open on Sunday afternoons to accommodate the demand from those ready to plant and grow all things from vegetation to trees! While they are open from March to October, you will find the plant production team planning, ordering, and doing the maintenance that goes on all year around at the greenhouse. People often think when the garden center is closed, the entire business is shut down but that's not the case at all. There's a lot of things going on behind the scenes and getting plants started while most people are warm and cozy in their homes during a winter snowstorm. January is actually the peak of their propagation and in February the transplanting line is running full speed every day! Go out and visit Barnes Greenhouse at 3235 Pleasant Plain in Trenton, take a look around, get some advice on what things would grow well in your yard, and find the perfect gifts as well. 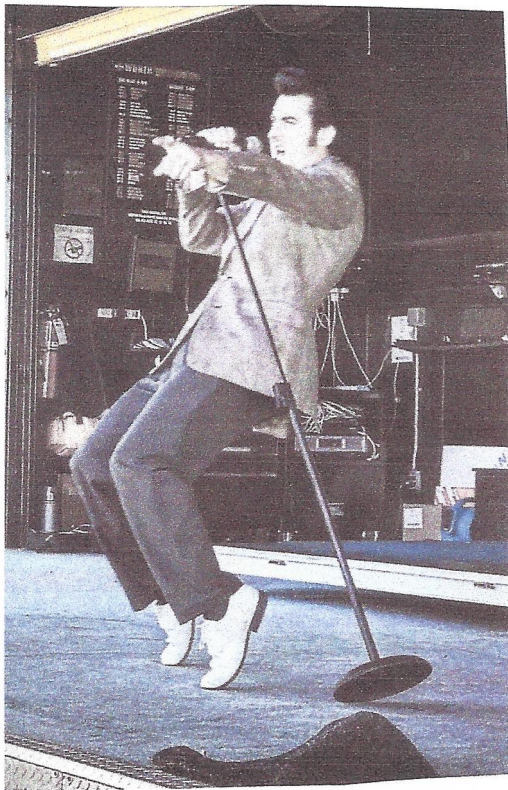

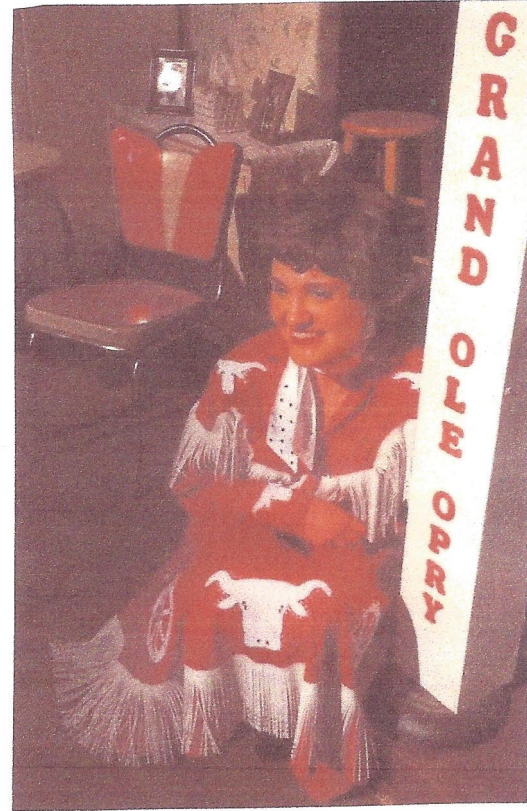
